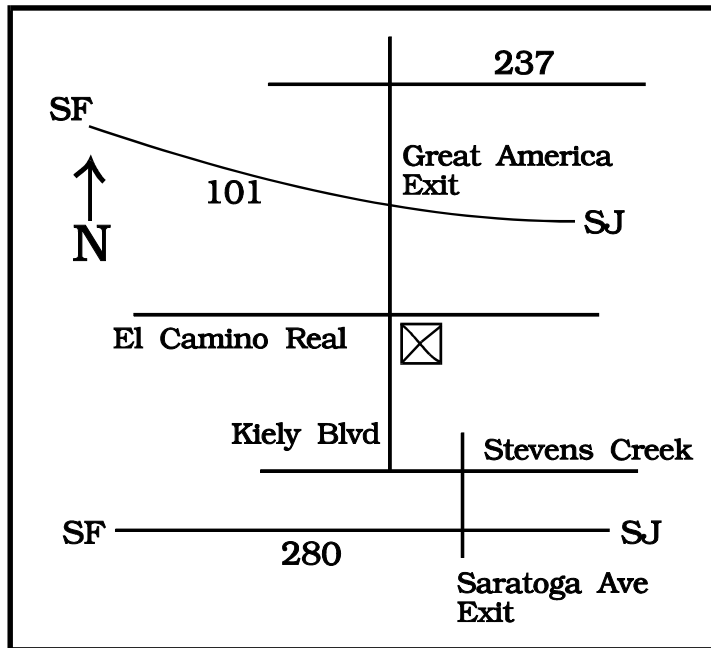

Tournament Rules

1. **Eligibility:** All bowlers must meet current year CBUSA Requirements for 2004-2005. Students must be enrolled full-time as determined by their institution with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. Graduate Students are eligible, according to full-time status at their institution. All participants must be current members of either ABC, WIBC or YABA, for the 04-05 season. All schools must have filed an intercollegiate application form with the Intercollegiate Bowling Program. Mixed teams will be allowed to compete in the Men's Division.
2. **Sanction:** ABC, WIBC and YABA - Collegiate Division (Sanction applied for)

3. **Entry Fees and Awards:**

Entries will be accepted on a first come-first serve basis. Teams may reserve spots by mail, fax, email or phone. Payment must be made prior to the tournament. Checks are payable to: **SJSU BOWLING TEAMS**

4. One Men's and one Women's team per school will be allowed. Second teams will be allowed based on availability. Teams will be allowed a maximum of 8 players on their roster. All bowlers on roster must be from same school.
5. **Format:** This tournament will consist of 9 games of five-person team match play (5 games Saturday and 4 games Sunday) and two (2) best 3 of 5 Baker game single elimination brackets for the top 6 Men's and 4 Women's teams; one after each Qualifying round. The winner of each bracket will face each other in a best 3 of 5 Baker match. If the same team wins both brackets each day then they are the winner of the tournament. If the winners of the brackets are the same and the runners-up each day are different then there will be a best 3 of 5 Baker match to determine second place. If the Winners are different then the loser of the final roll-off is runner-up.
In the Men's Division, the top two (2) teams will receive a bye into the second round. In both Divisions, the higher qualifying team will choose its starting lane. Teams will receive 10 minutes of practice prior to the Qualifying round. For those advancing to the Elimination round, teams will receive 10 minutes prior to each 3 of 5 match.
6. **Match Play Points:** For the Qualifying round, each team will bowl against the other team on the same pair of lanes. Teams will receive 50 pins bonus for each opponent defeated and 25 pins for each opponent tied. If a team is bowling unopposed then a blind score of 900 for Men and 800 for Women will be used.
7. **Position Ties:** In the case of a tie for the last spot in the Elimination round, a one game Baker match will be used to break it. If a tie exists for the 2nd and 3rd spots in the Men's Division for the Elimination round then a one game Baker match will be used to determine the higher spot. If ties still exist for the above then a 9th and 10th frame roll off will be bowled until the tie is broken. If a tie exists for the top 2 spots in the Men's Division then the team with the higher team game will earn the top spot.
8. **Elimination Round Ties:** If both teams have the same match play record at the end of a 5 game Baker match then the team with the higher pinfall for all 5 games will move on to the next round.
9. Events will start as scheduled; no make up frames will be allowed. Bowlers must take "0" for any missed frames.
10. **Substitutions:** Only one substitution can be made each game (this includes each Baker game), except in case of injury. Prior to *each* Baker game team lineups will be determined.
11. **Conduct:** Each team will either have the school coach, advisor, or team captain designated as the team representative. He or she will be responsible for the team at all times. Inappropriate behavior, as determined by the Tournament Officials, shall be cause for disqualification after the team has been given one warning. In addition, Coaches and players representing their college/university are prohibited from the following:
 - a. Drinking alcoholic beverages in the bowling center until competition has been completed for the day and/or while in team uniforms at any time.
 - b. Smoking not allowed in the bowling center during the tournament
12. **Lane Courtesy:** Teams will follow one lane courtesy.
13. **Other:** In the case of any unforeseen circumstances arising not covered by these rules, the Tournament Director has the authority to adopt a rule to cover that circumstance.
