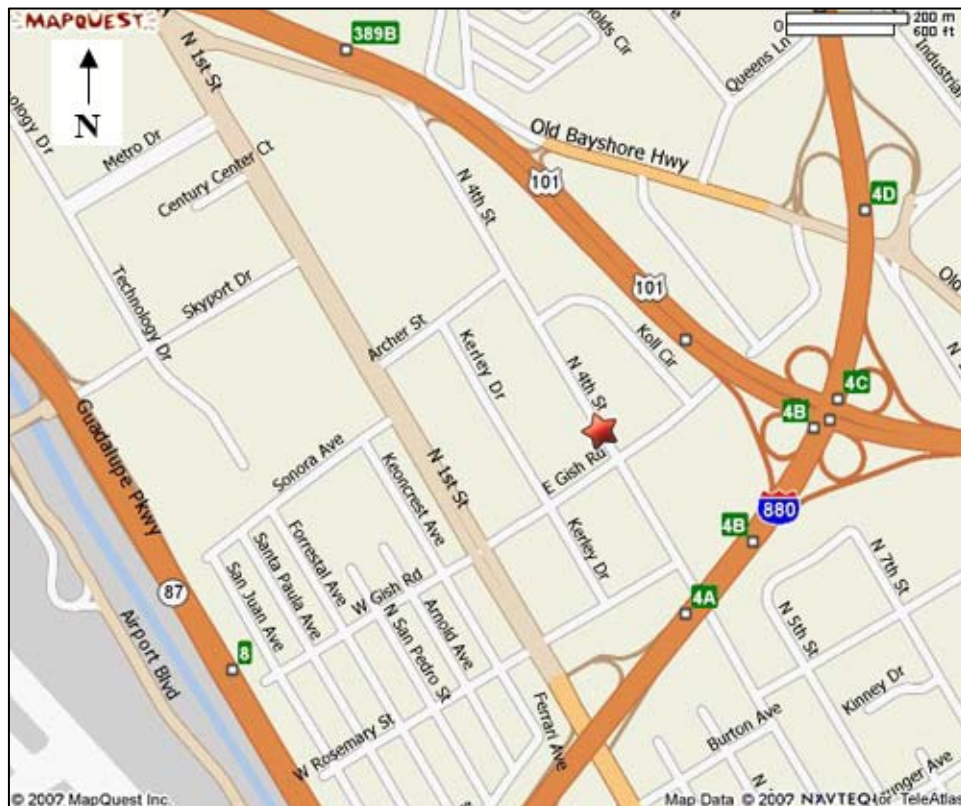

2008 Silicon Valley Classic Tournament Rules

1. **Eligibility:** All student-athletes must meet current year USBC – Collegiate Eligibility Requirements and be USBC adult or youth members for 2007-2008 season. All schools must have completed a Collegiate bowling membership form with the USBC Intercollegiate Bowling Program. Mixed teams must compete in the Men's Division.
2. **Sanction:** USBC - Collegiate Division (Sanction applied for)
3. **Entry Fees and Awards:**

100% of the Awards fees will be returned as awards or scholarship money.

Team scholarships paid 1 for every 3 teams. Entries will be accepted on a first come-first serve basis. Teams may reserve spots by mail, email or phone. Payment must be made prior to the tournament participation. Checks are payable to: **SJSU BOWLING TEAMS**

4. One Men's and one Women's team per school will be allowed. Second teams will be allowed based on availability. Teams will be allowed a maximum of 8 players on their roster. All bowlers on roster must be from the same school.
5. **Format:** This tournament will consist of 8 games of five-person team match play (4 games Saturday and 4 games Sunday) and three (3) best 3 of 5 Baker game single elimination brackets for the top 6 Men's and 4 Women's teams; one after each Qualifying round. The winner of each day's bracket will face each other in a best 3 of 5 Baker match. If the same team wins both brackets from each day, then they are the winner of the tournament. If the winners of the brackets are the same and the runners –up each day are different then there will be a best 3 of 5 Baker match to determine second place. If the Winners are different then the loser of the final roll-off is runner-up.
In a Men's Division with six (6) to nine (9) teams, the top two (2) teams will receive a bye into the second round. If 10-12 teams then an 8-team bracket with no byes. If 13 to 15 teams, then an 8-team bracket, with 2 byes. If there are 16 or more teams, then an 8-team bracket with the top four (4) teams will receiving a bye. In both Divisions, the higher qualifying team will choose its starting lane. Teams will receive 10 minutes of practice prior to the Qualifying round. For those advancing to the Elimination round, all teams will receive 10 minutes prior to the first best 3 of 5 match. Bowlers will receive 2 balls on each lane at the beginning of each subsequent match. Higher qualifying team chooses starting lane. Final standings determined by total qualifying pins with bonus added together for both days with the exception of the top 2 teams.
6. **Match Play Points:** For the Qualifying round, each team will bowl against the other team on the same pair of lanes. Teams will receive 50 pins bonus for each opponent defeated and 25 pins for each opponent tied. If a team is bowling unopposed a target score of 950 will be used, if there is a Women's Division then a target of 850 for Women will be used. A Pacer team may be used to fill an odd numbered field.
7. **Position Ties:** In the case of a tie for the last spot in the Baker Elimination round, a one game Baker match will be used to break it. If a tie exists for a bye and a non-bye position then a one game Baker match will be used to determine the higher spot. If a tie still exists for either of the above, then a (1) one ball sudden death shoot-out will be used until the tie is broken using one player chosen from each team. If a tie exists for any of the bye positions then the team with the higher scratch team game from that day will earn the higher spot.
8. **Elimination Round Ties:** If a baker game ends in a tie then each team will get ½ a point each. If both teams have the same match play record at the end of a 5 game Baker match then one (1) additional Baker game will be used to determine team that will move on to the next round. If a tie still exists, then a (1) one ball sudden death shoot-out will be used until the tie is broken using one player chosen from each team.
9. Events will start as scheduled; no make up frames will be allowed. Bowlers must take "0" for any missed frames.
10. **Substitutions:** (Rule 404-Collegiate) Three substitutions are permitted per regular team game and each Baker system game. A student-athlete once removed from competition cannot return to bowl for the remainder of the regular team game or Baker system game. Prior to *each* Baker game team lineups will be determined.
11. **Conduct:** Each team will either have the school coach, advisor, or team captain designated as the team representative. He or she will be responsible for the team at all times. Inappropriate behavior, as determined by the Tournament Officials, shall be cause for disqualification after the team has been given one warning. In addition, Coaches and players representing their college/university are prohibited from the following:
 - a. Drinking alcoholic beverages in the bowling center until competition has been completed for the day and/or while in team uniforms at any time.
 - b. Smoking not allowed in the bowling center during the tournament
12. **Lane Courtesy:** Teams will follow one (1) lane courtesy in order to speed up play.
13. **Other:** In the case of any unforeseen circumstances arising not covered by these rules, the Tournament Director has the authority to adopt a rule to cover that circumstance.
